Where can I find details and additional information about a policy such as when it was adopted, or who the Responsible Executive is?

Each policy has its own webpage. At the bottom of each policy page you can find important details and information by clicking on the "info" button. See the image below for example:

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Can I download policies as a PDF?

You can download any policy as a PDF document. To do so, click the download button at the bottom of a policy page. See example below:

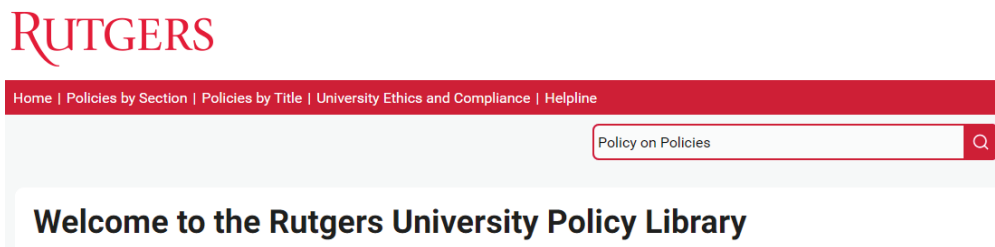
Frequently Asked Questions

What is the best way to search for a specific policy?

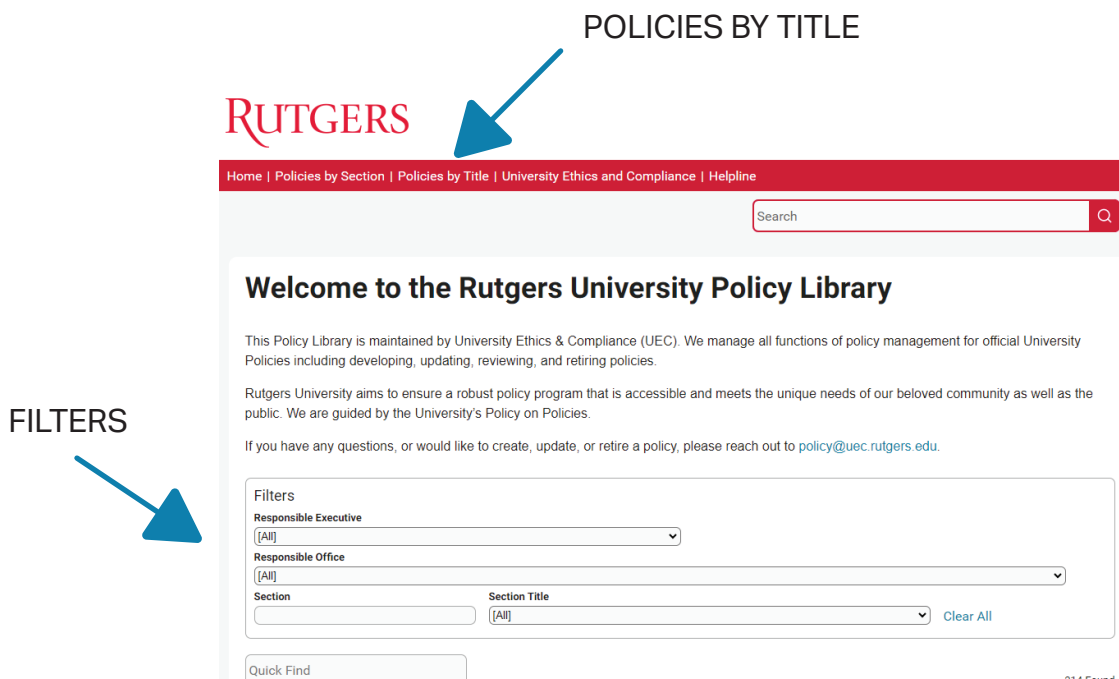
We are in the process of updating some search features based on some feedback we have received. We suggest the following for conducting a policy search:

Searching by Title

Method 1: Type the name of the policy you are looking for in the Search Box at the top of the page:



Method 2: Navigate to the "Policies by Title" page at the top of your screen. On that page, all policies in the library appear in alphabetical order. You can filter for specific policies based on specific attributes such as "Responsible Office."



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Searching by Number

Method 1: Navigate to the "Policies by Title" page at the top of your screen. On that page, all policies in the library appear in alphabetical order. Type the policy number you would like to view in "Section" search box
