10.1.12 SUMMER SESSION

- A. Each Chancellor shall be responsible for the administration of a campus Summer Session. All undergraduate and graduate instructional programs offered, during the period beginning on or about Commencement Day and extending to the opening of the next ensuing first term, shall be conducted under the auspices of a campus Summer Session, except that the President may authorize any college, school, or Faculty to conduct instruction during this period under its own auspices, charged against its own budget. No course or other instructional activity shall be offered for credit in a Summer Session unless such course or activity shall have been approved for credit by the legislative body of one of the colleges, schools, or Faculties in the University.
- B. This policy will not apply to Robert Wood Johnson Medical School, School of Health Related Professions, Rutgers School of Dental Medicine, New Jersey Medical School, Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, School of Public Health, and School of Nursing (former UMDNJ School of Nursing), due to the nature of their educational programs and their individual academic calendars.
