### 10.1.2 ACADEMIC UNITS

Academic Units. The established academic units of the University are as follows:

#### A. Faculties, Colleges, and Schools

1. Camden: Camden College of Arts and Sciences; Faculty of Arts and Sciences Camden; School of Business-Camden; School of Law-Camden; School of Nursing-Camden; University College-Camden; Graduate School-Camden.
2. Newark: Newark College of Arts and Sciences; Faculty of Arts and Sciences Newark; University College-Newark; School of Criminal Justice; School of Law-Newark; Rutgers Business School: Undergraduate- Newark; School of Public Affairs and Administration; Graduate School-Newark.
3. New Brunswick/Piscataway: School of Arts and Sciences; School of Environmental and Biological Sciences; Edward J. Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy; Mason Gross School of the Arts; School of Engineering; Rutgers Business School: Undergraduate-New Brunswick; School of Management and Labor Relations; School of Communication and Information; School of Social Work; Graduate School-New Brunswick; Graduate School of Applied and Professional Psychology; Graduate School of Education.
4. Newark and New Brunswick: Rutgers Business School: Graduate Programs Newark/New Brunswick.
5. Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences: Robert Wood Johnson Medical School; New Jersey Medical School; Rutgers School of Dental Medicine; School of Health Related Professions; School of Nursing; College of Nursing; School of Public Health; Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences; Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy.
