**RECREATIONAL FACILITIES**

A. All recreational facilities shall be available for use to all employees employed within Rutgers positions (non-legacy University Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (UMDNJ) positions). Employees employed within Rutgers-legacy UMDNJ staff, faculty positions, and legacy UMDNJ retirees will need to purchase a membership to access campus specific recreational facilities; the memberships shall be posted on the appropriate campus recreational facilities website.

B. ~~Rutgers University-Camden: Campus~~ Recreational and athletic facilities ~~on at Rutgers University-the Camden Campus~~ include the recreation center, gymnasium, squash/racquet ball courts, weight room, aquatic center, soccer field, and softball field and are available for use, but are subject to the scheduling requirements of the facility.
